Bible Survey, part 11 The New Testament - Colossians "Complete in Christ"

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"For I want you to know how greatly I strive in prayer for you, and for those at Laodicea, and for all who have not personally seen my face." Colossians 2:1

The churches at Colossae and Laodicea were actually established by a man named "Epaphras."

"All over the world, the Gospel is bearing fruit, just as it has been doing among you from the day you first heard it . . . from **Epaphras**, our dear brother . . ." Colossians 1:6-7

"Honey Bee Strategy":

- Paul would "pollinate" people passing through Ephesus with the Gospel...
- Then, like "spiritual honey bees," they would take the Gospel back home with them . . .
- And "pollinate" their home towns for Christ

"The Prison Epistles"

- Ephesians
- Philippians
- Colossians
- Philemon

Paul wrote all four of these letters from "prison" in Rome (A.D. 61-62) while he was awaiting trial before Emperor Nero.

Paul's letters to the churches:

1st **section** = theological issues

2nd **section** = practical Christian-life issues

In Colossians 4:12, we learn that Epaphras had come to Rome to visit Paul in jail and reported to Paul about **false teaching** that had crept into the churches of Colossae and Laodicea.

This false teaching concerned the "Person of Christ."

People were teaching that Jesus was a "created being" - and not "God Himself in the flesh."

This (of course) is a problem because – if Jesus is **not** the (1) **sinless**, (2) **incarnate**, (3) **Second Person of the Godhead** – then His death on the cross is worthless for our redemption and salvation.

Paul writes to correct this serious heresy – and in doing so – gives us (Colossians chapters 1 & 2) the **most comprehensive single passage** in all the Bible – on the Person of Christ.

#1 - Jesus = God Himself wrapped in human flesh

"He (Jesus Christ) is the (visible) image of the invisible God ..." Colossians 1:15

"God was pleased to have all His fullness dwell in Him (Jesus Christ)." Colossians 1:19

"For in Christ, all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form." Colossians 2:9

"He (Jesus) is the radiance of God's glory and the **exact representation** of God's 'hupostasis' ['essence/nature/intrinsic being'] . . ." Hebrews 1:3

"... He who has seen Me has seen the Father..." John 14:9 "I and the Father are one." John 10:30



Nicene Creed:

"We believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, being of **one substance** with the Father."

"one substance" = (Greek) "homo" (same) + "ousios" (essence)

The Nicene Creed was intended to affirm that **God the Son** and **God the Father** are of the **EXACT SAME substance/essence/nature/ and intrinsic being** as one another.

 $\boldsymbol{Dan\ Brown}:$ The deity of Christ was $\boldsymbol{INVENTED}$ at the Council of Nicea.

Truth: The deity of Christ was merely **CODIFIED** at the Council of Nicea.

As we can all see – the deity of Christ is what true Christianity believed in A.D. 62 – **when Paul wrote about it to the Colossians**!

#2 - Jesus = the Creator of the universe

"For by Him (Jesus), all things were created, both in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible . . . all things were created by Him and for Him." Colossians 1:16

"By Him (Jesus) all things were made; and without Him nothing was made that has been made." John 1:3

Here we have another **powerful affirmation of the deity of Christ**.

"In the beginning, God made the heavens and the earth." Genesis 1:1 "For by Jesus, all things were created . . ." Colossians 1:16

So – if "God" did this – and "Jesus" did this – then who can Jesus be but God?

#3 – Jesus = the Owner of the universe

"... all things were created by Him and for Him." Colossians 1:16

"In these last days, God has spoken to us by His Son, whom He appointed **heir of all things** . . ." Hebrews 1:2

Right now – our world is in open rebellion against Jesus' ownership of the universe – but this is just a temporary situation!

[On that day] "... every knee will bow ... and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." Philippians 2:10-11

#4 - Jesus = the Upholder of the universe He created

- "... in Him (Jesus) all things **hold together** ..." Colossians 1:17
- "... He (Jesus) **upholds** the universe by the word of His power." Hebrews 1:3
- "... by the word of His power."

Jesus is so powerful – that He doesn't even need to lift His pinkie to hold the universe together – all he has to do is **say the word**!

#5 – Jesus = the Redeemer of mankind

"In whom (Jesus), we have **redemption**, the forgiveness of sins." Colossians 1:14

"... He (Jesus) made peace [between us and God] by the blood of His cross." Colossians 1:20 "In Him (Jesus), we have redemption, the forgiveness of our sins, through His blood ..." Ephesians 1:7

"You were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your empty way of life . . . But with the **precious blood of Christ**." 1 Peter 1:18-19

Jesus' blood doesn't redeem everybody – only those who place their **full trust in it** for their redemption.

In the book of Colossians, Paul gives us the **most concise and powerful summary** of the person of Christ anywhere in the Bible.

#1 - God Himself wrapped in human flesh

- #2 The **Creator** of the universe
- #3 The **Owner** of the universe
- #4 The **Upholder** of the universe

#5 – The **Redeemer** of those members of mankind who will put their full trust in His shed blood for their redemption

So What?

[as a follower of Jesus Christ] "In Him (Jesus), you have been made **complete**." Colossians 2:10

"... He circumcised us with a circumcision not made with hands." Colossians 2:11

"He reconciled us to God \dots having made peace between us and God through the blood of His cross." Colossians 1:20

"When we were dead in our sins, He made us [spiritually] alive . . ." Colossians 2:13a

"... and forgave us all our sins." Colossians 2:13b

"And canceled the debt we owed [a holy God] ... by nailing it to the cross." Colossians 2:14

"... raised us up [to eternal life]." Colossians 2:12

"... [Put] Christ in us, the hope of glory [indwelling Holy Spirit]." Colossians 1:27

[By the indwelling Holy Spirit] "... we are **sealed** for the day of redemption." Ephesians 4:30

"Sealed" = [Greek] "branding an animal"

By putting the Holy Spirit inside of us – God has "**branded**" **us spiritually** – so that every angel and demon and Satan himself **KNOWS** – that we belong to God for all eternity!

[as a follower of Jesus Christ] "In Him (Jesus), you have been made complete." Colossians 2:10

- In God's family (Colossians 2:1)
- Reconciled with God (Colossians 1:20)
- Peace between us and God (Colossians 1:20)
- Spiritually alive to God (Colossians 2:13)
- Sins are forgiven (Colossians 2:13)
- Debt against us is canceled (Colossians 2:14)
- Have eternal life (Colossians 2:12)
- Christ lives inside us (Colossians 1:27)
- Branded as God's property for all eternity (Ephesians 4:30)

When it comes to our redemption in Jesus Christ, there are no "missing pieces" and nothing we need to do to "supplement" what Jesus has already done for us!

We are complete in Christ! (Colossians 2:10)

"Jesus is the mediator of a better covenant that has been founded on better promises [than any other plan of salvation in the universe]." Hebrews 8:6

"... we have lost our first love." (Revelation 2:4)
